Hi David, thanks for your interest in Retool. We will not be pursuing this legislation in Retool. If you look at the county map referenced, there are only two churches that could reasonably accommodate adding residential and they are on the Frederick Avenue, so such can be addressed through the CD Zone process. Other churches are located in areas that have been designated as "Employment Nodes" in the Housing Element that clearly states these are not appropriate areas for residential. The County has far more areas where contextually this could be applied. We continue, both in policy and in Retool, to encourage a diversity of housing options and to address the affordability gap.
